



## RETURN to PLAY GUIDELINES

### Game Time, Field Schedules, Operations

Quads will have staggered 15-minute start times  
15 Minutes will be built in between game times to clean  
restrooms (starting at the end of the last game  
completed in that scheduled start time and quad).

After cleaning process, teams scheduled for the next game time  
can rotate into the quad. Plate umpire will officiate from behind  
the mound"

Teams will split their rosters and coaches for dugout seating, half  
in main dugout and other half in what was originally the "parent  
viewing area" (starting at the end of the last game  
completed in that scheduled start time and quad).

Parents must stay behind the outfield fence under local social  
distancing orders"

Batting Cages – 4 Teams, 1 Team per half cage as marked

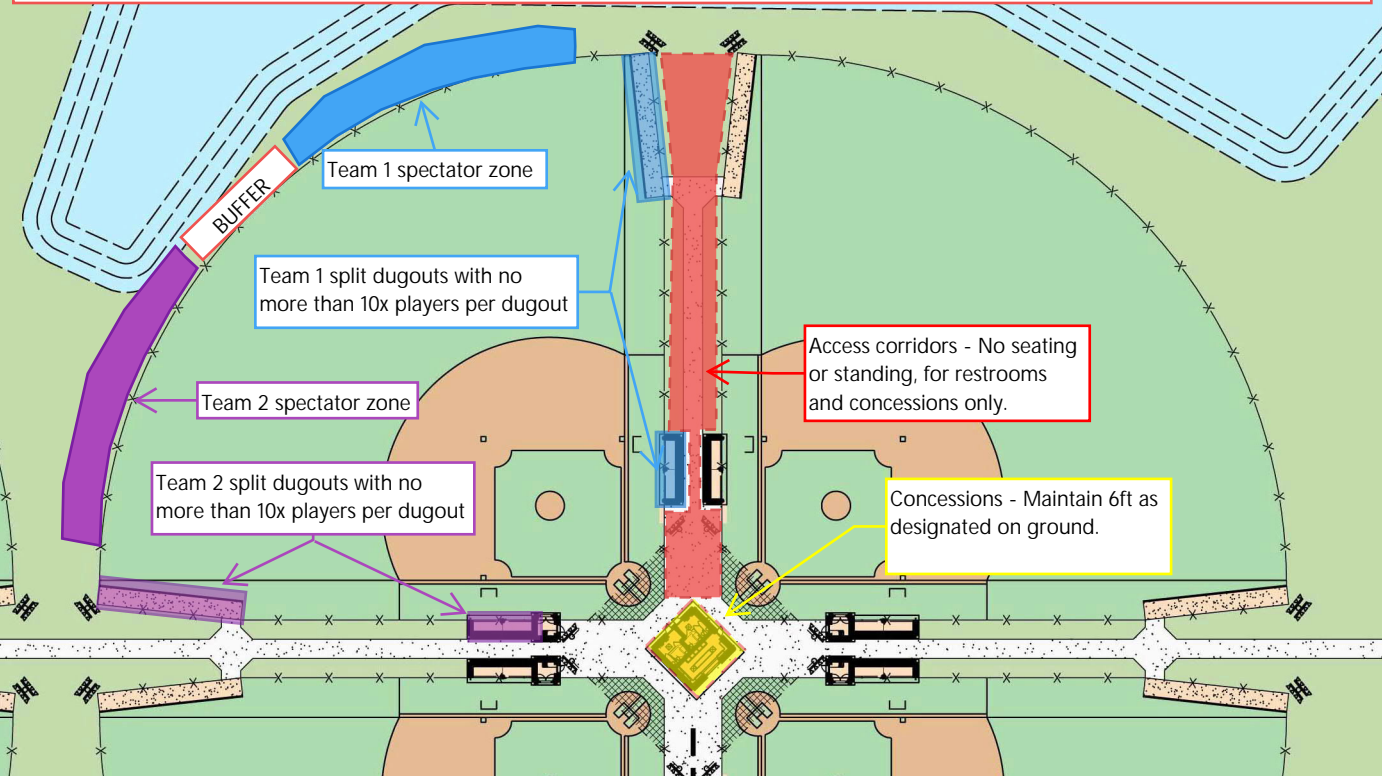
### Social Distancing

Batting cages will be available to 4x teams at a time with 4 vacant cages being used as buffers.
